Wei Tan boarded the Conception because she had moved to Santa Barbara just four months earlier and wanted to explore her new home.

When Tan was 10, she and her family visited Tioman, an island on the east coast of Malaysia known for its coral, sea sponges and shipwrecks. Wei insisted on going diving, so the whole family went with her.

Tan graduated from UC Berkeley in May with a master's in engineering, and attended the University of Michigan as an undergraduate, her sister said. She had recently taken a job as a data scientist at Evidation Health, a health-care technology company.

"Our hearts are broken," said Christine Lemke, the company's co-founder and president, in a statement. "Her smile lit up the world and she'll be sorely missed."

Tan, 26, was excited to buy new furniture for her Goleta apartment, said her sister Cheerin Tan. Their parents had promised to visit and check out the apartment over Christmas.

Cheerin Tan said she hopes her sister, who loved spending time outdoors, saw beautiful coral formations and chased some sea turtles before settling down to sleep. Her family is comforted, somewhat, knowing Wei "was doing something she loved in the last few moments of her life."

U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service biologist Kendra Chan and her father were among those killed in Monday's fire, authorities said.

On Saturday, the agency's officials said they were "devastated" by the loss of 26-year-old Chan and her father.

"It is with inconceivable sadness that we share today the passing of one of our own," U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service said. "We're devastated by this heart-breaking news and our thoughts remain with her loved ones during this unimaginably difficult time."

The wildlife agency described Chan as a "remarkable human being" whose "positive energy enriched the lives of those she touched through her love of nature, wildlife, and the outdoors."

"She was a force for good, and led a life that made the world around her a better place. She loved the ocean, from surfing and diving to tide pooling. Her passion, curiosity, and enthusiasm for all living things - from tiny skeleton shrimp to the tidewater goby - were infectious. We will miss her dearly, and will carry her energy with us in the days ahead," the agency said.
